

BALLOCHNECK

From Glasgow Airport

Follow signs for the Erskine Bridge along the M8 westbound. On crossing the bridge, drive west along the A82 through Dumbarton northwest towards Loch Lomond.

Then just before Loch Lomond turn off towards Balloch along the A811. Stay on the A811 and follow the signs for Stirling (this will take you through Gartocharn and past Drymen, and across the A81).

Buchlyvie is the next village along the A811.

From Edinburgh Airport

Follow signs for Stirling along the M9 Westbound.

Shortly after junction 7 to the Kincardine Bridge be sure to stay in the right lane towards Stirling as the M9 splits in two at junction 8.

At junction 9 ignore the the exit to Stirling Services and city centre,

following signs for Perth and turn off at the next junction 10 The Trossachs National Park and Blair Drummond Safari Park.

In the first round about follow signs for Stirling and in the next three follow the signs for the A811 Erskine Bridge and Loch Lomond.

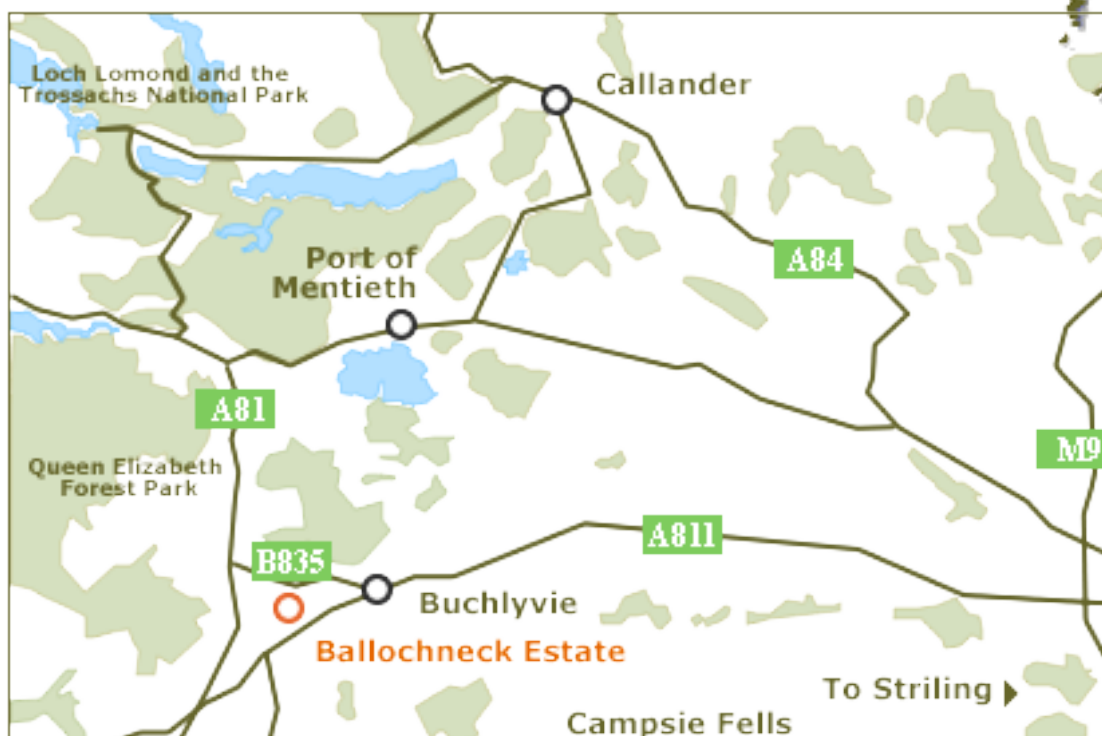
Once on the A811 it will take you straight to Buchlyvie.

In Buchlyvie

Take the B835 to Aberfoyle. On leaving the village pass over a small bridge. The entrance to Ballochneck is 200 metres further on on the left.

The drive is 1 mile long.
